- part of the library information system in Slovenia
- cultural and educational institutions
- library materials are: collected, stored, processed and put into use
- libraries: disseminate knowledge, education and culture, provide information about different fields of knowledge to all categories of the population, irrespective of age, gender, education, political or religious beliefs, ethnic origin, language or social status

- final event with special guests, interview with students, presentation of documentary ...








